Directions from I-405:

From I-405, take exit 24 for NE 195th St. Head east on 195th St (this is a right turn from the south, and a left turn from the north). Then take the second right on 120th Ave NE. The site will be on your right in less than half a mile.

Stratification

0-200 Pairs and Teams:	0-50, 50-100, 100-200
0-750 Pairs:	0-200, 200-500, 500-750
Open Pairs:	0-500, 500-2000, 2000+
BCD Swiss Teams:	0-500, 500-1000, 1000-2000
A/X Swiss Teams	0-3000, 3000+

- Stratification is based on the average MPs of the pair/team
- In all limited events, no player may exceed the upper limit.
 - In 0-200 events, no player may have more than 200 masterpoints
 - In 0-750 events, no player may have more than 750 masterpoints
 - In 0-2000 events, no player may have more than 2000 masterpoints
- Midchart conventions are permitted in Qualifying Pairs and A/X Swiss
