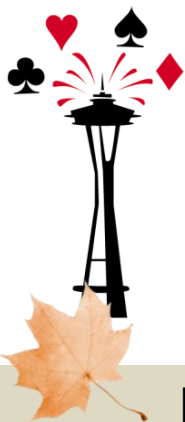

Stratified Pairs:	0-500, 500-2000, 2000+
BCD Swiss Teams:	0-500, 500-1000, 1000-2000
A/X Swiss Teams	0-3000, 3000+
